Step 1: Gather four empty baskets/laundry baskets and one trash bag and take them to your room. Tape labels to each basket.

Step 2: Pull everything out from on top of and under the beds, corners, closet, and every single thing on the floor, and put it in a pile in the middle of the room.

Step 3: Make the beds with clean sheets. Put the dirty sheets in the basket marked "laundry."

Step 4: Hunt through the pile for trash and put trash in the trash bag.

Step 5: Sort the pile in the middle of the floor into the labeled baskets (keep an eye out for any trash you missed).

Step 6: Return books from book basket to bookshelves (make sure library books are kept separate and given to mom!).

Step 7: Put toys from toy basket away.

Step 8: Put things that belong in other rooms away where they belong.

Step 9: Take basket full of laundry to the washing machine and start a load of laundry (ask for help if you need it).

Step 10: Throw trash away.

Step 11: Vacuum your room.

Step 1: Pick up dirty clothes, rugs, and put them in a dirty laundry basket.

Step 3: Pick up trash off of the floor and throw it away.

Step 4: Pick up everything that doesn't belong off of the floor and put it away where it belongs.

Step 5: Pick up everything that doesn't belong off of the counters and put it away where it belongs.

Step 6: Wipe out the sink and faucets.

Step 7: Clean the countertops.

Step 8: Wipe down the toilet seat, under the seat, top of toilet, and sides of toilet.

Step 9: Clean the inside of the toilet (ask for help if you need it).

Step 10: Clean the tub and shower.

Step 11: Sweep and mop the floor.

Step 12: Empty the trash can.

Step 13: Hang fresh towels.

Step 14: Replace toilet paper if needed.
